The registration should be in the name of bidder for Individual, Proprietorship firm, Partnership firm, Company registered under Companies Act. Whereas for participation of Joint Venture / Consortium through GeM portal, the registration of bidder should be in the Name of Lead Member of the Joint Venture / Consortium and the submitted document against eligibility criteria should be in the name of Joint Venture / Consortium.

- ii. Bidders will have right to modify / withdraw their bids during extended period of submission of bids as per GeM Functionality
- iii. After extension, as stated above the tender shall be opened irrespective of available No. of bids on the extended date of opening of tender.
- iv. The validity period of the Tender should be decided based on the final end date of submission of bids.
- v. The Employer reserves the right to issue corrigendum/addendum and it shall be binding on part of the Bidders.
- vi. It is the bidder's responsibility to comply with the system requirement i.e., hardware, software and internet connectivity at bidder's premises to access the GeM portal. Under any circumstances NEC shall not be liable to the bidders for any direct/indirect loss or damages incurred by them arising out of incorrect use of the e-tender system or internet connectivity failures.
- vii. The Company is not under any obligation to accept the lowest Bid/Bids and reserves the right to reject any or all the Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever, and also to distribute the work and allot the work/works to more than one Bidder or accept the tender in part and not in its entirety, as its sole discretion.
- viii. The company reserves the right to extend the date of submission and opening of bid or to cancel the bid without assigning any reason whatsoever. **Any addendum/ corrigendum/ date extension etc. in respect of above tender will be published in GeM portal only. i. **Procurement of Services through GeM for Services**

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DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK WITH TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Bamboo plantation shall be carried out over 10.0 hectares area in the OB Dump of Tirap OCP (Tirap Colliery). Spacing of the Saplings is 7 m center to center. A total of 204 saplings per hectare shall be planted, with a spacing of 7 meters center-to-center between saplings. Thus, a total of 2040 bamboo saplings shall be planted over the 10.0 ha area.
2. Location : Existing Old Over Burden (OB) Dumps area of Tirap OCP, North Eastern Coalfields, Coal India Limited, Margherita, Assam.
3. The pit size for planting each sapling shall not be less than 60 cm x 60 cm x 60 cm.
4. The period of creation/plantation shall be 180 days from the date of commencement of work.
5. The maintenance period shall be 1095 days (3 years) from the completion of the plantation.
6. Site preparation shall include jungle/ clearing, levelling, digging of pits (60 cm x 60 cm x 60 cm), return filling, application of manure and compost, regular watering, and installation of bamboo or other guards (Khacha) to protect the saplings.
7. During the maintenance period, the following activities must be undertaken each year:
 - i) Three cycles of weeding in every four months;
 - ii) Vacancy filling for failed saplings;
 - iii) Soil working and mulching;
 - iv) Regular application of manure and compost;
 - v) Regular watering;
 - vi) Use of bamboo or other guards (Khacha) for protection of saplings.
8. The bamboo species selected for plantation must be of native varieties, such as:
 - i) Jati (*Bambusa tulda*),
 - ii) Bhaluka (*Bambusa balcooa*),
 - iii) Kotoha (*Bambusa bambos*),
 - iv) Etc local species.
9. Supply of bamboo saplings shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
10. The contractor shall replace any damaged, dead, or unhealthy plants during the maintenance period.
11. Agent or Project officer (PO) of Tirap OCP (Tirap Colliery) would be the engineer in-charge of the work.
12. Upon completion of plantation, the contractor must provide a written report duly signed and sealed of the contractor and mine / project authorities, detailing the local names and number of bamboo saplings planted at the site.
13. The contractor shall ensure minimum 80% of survival rate of plants at the end of the each maintenance year. However, if the survival rate is less than 80 %, Pro-rata deduction will be made e.g. if survival rate is 75 %, then 6.25 % [$\{(80-75)/80\} \times 100 = 6.25 \%$] of the total cost of plantation or contract value and will be deducted from the bills and if the bill is not sufficient, then deduction will be made from the pending bills of the contractor with NEC.
14. On completion of the job, contractor shall hand over the plantation site to NEC with a minimum of 80 % survival rate and average height of 2.5 m of Plants. Any plant with height less than 1.25 m at the end of maintenance period shall

not be considered for counting. Any plant not satisfying these criteria will not be taken in to account for counting and payment.

15. Joint inspections shall be conducted in every six months during the maintenance period (up to the completion 3rd year maintenance) by the Mine/Project Authorities and the Contractor to monitor plant survivability and job progress. The inspection reports must be countersigned by Mine / Project Authority (Agent/ PO) and Contractor and submitted by the contractor.
16. **The contractor should engage local communities or SHGs (Self-Help Groups), (focusing on women empowerment) for the execution of the job. Relevant records such Hindrance Register and Site Order book or other registers (as required) must be maintained submitted in duly signed and sealed form by the contractor.**
17. **Rate submitted by the bidder should be inclusive of transportation of sapling, providing water as required and maintenance of fencing/ guard as required and other materials and activities required by the bidder for the successful completion of the job.**
